CTSW are an established Salisbury charity which provides a lifeline helping to relieve loneliness and isolation and support those people that find it difficult to get out and about from their homes.

A huge factor in reducing the quality of life for the elderly and disabled people is not being able to get around. Many cannot afford taxis or reach buses and have no other means of transport available.



CTSW focuses on providing door-to-door transport making it possible for people to do the things most of us take for granted, to go shopping, attend medical or hairdresser appointments, local day centres, visit family, or simply to meet up with friends.

Without us, many people would be confined to their homes. The majority of people we help are elderly, frail or disabled, we always endeavour to help anyone in genuine need.

CTSW Services

All services (except Hoppa) are personalised, collecting you from and returning you to your home. CTSW provide support into the car or bus making sure you are safe in your seat.

Drivers are friendly, happy to help, aware of your mobility needs to provide safe access for you and other passengers.

Shopper Buses

For those people registered with a Concessionary Bus Pass, **CTSW** operates a variety of scheduled '**Shopper Bus**' routes, in Salisbury and surrounding areas, no route is the same each day. Most routes are weekly, while others run alternate weeks or fortnightly.

All our services are personalised, we collect you from your home, help you on the bus and make sure you are secure in your seat. On the return journey we help you back on the bus with any shopping. Additionally drivers will be happy to take your shopping into your home if required. For further information call to find out which one our Shopper bus routes will best suit your needs.



Car Scheme

A door-to-door car service that operates between Monday and Friday and available to residents of Salisbury. Bookings can be made to visit family and friends, leisure activities, to go shopping, to the hairdressers or attend medical appointments.

Our car drivers are all wonderful volunteers, that give up their own spare time to help. At an arranged time, we collect you from your home and take you to where you want to go and if arranged, back home again. Group Bookings

With many years experience we are happy to provide a driver to transport you to your desired destination, taking out the hassle of driving for yourselves ensuring your group is transported safely and affordably.

We provide minibus transport for affiliated groups and organisations that do not have their own transport. So whether you are planning a special day trip out for your senior group, church, day centre or other, register your organisation with CTSW. *(Our minibuses carry up to a capacity of sixteen seated people, with some buses able to accommodate wheelchair users).*



Amesbury Hoppa

CTSW also operate a popular public accessible community bus known as the **Amesbury HOPPA**. The HOPPA connects the Amesbury community, enabling people to access schools, town shops, places of business and leisure (food chains) within the Solstice Park development.

The HOPPA runs on a Monday to Saturday time-tabled service covering two routes; stopping at various points on route (including Solstice Park, Tesco Supermarket, Archers Gate and the town centre). **Travel** is free for Concessionary Bus Pass Holders and children up to 5 years old, for all others travel is relatively inexpensive.
